Chico Friends of the Butte County Library is dedicated to supporting activities and purchases by the Library.

Here is an incomplete list of how we have supported the Library so far this fiscal year (our fiscal year runs from July, 2019 to June, 2020).

- \$30,764 new books and digital media
 \$3,138 newspapers and magazines
 \$2,174 Celebration de las Americas 2019 sponsorship
 \$2,208 staff conferences
 \$1,245 library programs and craft supplies
 \$1,000 Trivia Bee for Literacy 2019
 \$937 library maintenance and repairs
- \$795 Sunday movie licenses

Our total income for this fiscal year to date (FYTD) is \$49,953. Our total expenses for this FYTD are \$44,924. Ninety-four% of our expenses directly support the library and 6% are operational expenses (things like insurance, fundraising, postage, printing, storage, etc.)

Our sources of income are contributions and grants, fundraising (weekly used book sale), and investments. We have no paid staff and are grateful for the volunteers that make this all possible.
